2. Each entry must include a completed entry form.
3. Three copies of each film – 3 DVD's (along with 3 copies of the synopsis in English)
4. Film must be less then **60 minutes**.
5. Your submission will not be returned.
6. Acceptance of all entries is at the sole discretion of SAIMC
7. SAIMC reserves the right to accept or reject any entries without assigning any reason.
8. The decision of the jury will be final and binding.
9. Film produced in a language other than English must have English subtitles.

Each entry must be accompanied by the following:

1. The filmmaker's Resume.
2. Bonafide certificate of the student.
3. A photocopy of the filmmaker's student identification.
4. Appropriate clearances of right from the college authorities.
5. A detailed description of the production method.
